Green Travel Plan



We operate a Green Travel Plan and encourage our students, staff and visitors to access the Penryn Campus via public transport where possible (see over). Revenue from car parking is used to subsidise the local bus service for our students and staff, to encourage sustainable travel.

If driving to the campus is unavoidable we offer a range of parking solutions. Students and staff can either use our pay as you leave parking system, or apply for a permit, which allows regular use of our car parks for an annual fee. Considerate parking

If you can't avoid using your car for your visit we advise you to park at the Penryn Campus and not in neighbouring streets.

All students, staff and visitors to the Penryn Campus have to pay to park.

Please park within a marked bay to avoid receiving a fine.

The Reserved Visitor Parking is not free but allows you to reserve spaces in advance for your guests.

If you don't have a permit, please pay the appropriate charge at one of our pay stations before you exit, so that the barrier will rise and allow you to leave.

If you hold a long stay permit for Glasney Student Village you must only park in accommodation parking areas or Car Park A.

Please respect our staff – we are here to help. Abuse will not be tolerated and may lead to disciplinary action.



Green travel alternatives

We aim to make it as easy as possible for you to choose 'green' or sustainable transport to campus where possible to reduce our environmental impact.

We work with transport providers and other organisations to provide:

Affordable and convenient public transport

- Dedicated University **buses every 10 minutes** through the day at peak hours (term time)
- **Express U3 bus** with direct routes between Falmouth and Penryn Campuses.
- Subsidised local **bus journeys only £1** for journeys between Penryn Campus and Falmouth Campus/town with your ID card.
- An Integrated Travel Card – the **Fal River Mussel Card Uni** provides unlimited travel on Cornwall's buses and ferries in the Fal River area for one annual fee.
- **Regular train services** between Falmouth, Penryn and Truro.
